"WHAT A FATHER DOES, Part 2"

PROVERBS 2:1-8

TRUTH: There's no excuse for a rebellious child (Proverbs 3:11).

TRUTH: Every child must be taught to obey, and discipline is a must.

TRUTH: Rebellion to your God-given authority is driven from the heart of a child by a rod of discipline (Proverbs 10:13).

INSIGHT: Physical punishment done in love is an effective corrective.

*What must dads teach their sons?

I. CHOOSE COMPANIONS CAREFULLY.

INSIGHT: At the top of dad's protection list is dating.

DAD MAXIM: We never let hormones or hearts overrule our heads.

*Two ways to "man-up" in the dating life of your son/daughter:

- 1. Be informed.
- 2. Be involved.

DATING MAXIM: Dad reserves the right of refusal on any potential boy or girl.

TRUTH: Dads are responsible to help sons/daughters choose their friends.

II. CONTROL THE BODY.

TRUTH: "The" dominant theme of the first of Proverbs is about adultery and sexual immorality (Proverbs 2:16, 6:20, 32).

*God's warning about adultery:

- 1. Adultery brings disgrace.
- 2. Adultery brings reproach never blotted out.

TRUTH: Faithful dads teach their sons sexual purity.

III. ENJOY YOUR WIFE (Proverbs 5:15).

TRUTH: Sexual thirst in a man or woman is to be met only with the spouse.

IV. FINAL LESSONS

- 1. Guard the mouth (Proverbs 4:20, 24).
- 2. Pursue work (Proverbs 6:6).

TRUTH: Teach your son/daughter to work without supervision.
