RESIST ISOLATION

GENESIS 3:6-19 (NASB)

INSIGHT: Fear is the number one source of ruined relationships.

TRUTH: Every temptation has one motivation... to play God.

I. THE POWER OF FEAR IN YOUR RELATIONSHIPS

The three fears that ruin relationships:

1. The fear of disclosure makes me hide (Genesis 3:9-10).

INSIGHT: I was afraid/so I hid go together.

TRUTH: Fear and hiding are cause and effect.

TRUTH: One of your deepest needs is to be loved, but your greatest fear is people seeing the real you (Genesis 3:7b).

2. Fear of disapproval makes me defensive.

TRUTH: The more critical a person is, the more they fear disapproval.

INSIGHT: The more I fear your disapproval, the more I will highlight your faults.

INSIGHT: The more insecure someone is, the greater their need to get their way.

3. Fear of losing control makes me demanding.

TRUTH: The more insecure you are, the greater your need to get your way.

INSIGHT: The more out of control you feel, the more controlling you become.

II. LOVE IS THE ANTIDOTE FOR FEAR (1 John 4:18).

TRUTH: If you are fearful, then you struggle to love consistently.

HOW DO WE LEARN TO LOVE?

- 1. Invite God daily to love through you.
- 2. Remember how God sees you every day.

INSIGHT: I can't be loving to anyone unless I am secure in God's love.

WHAT GOD THINKS ABOUT ME IN JESUS CHRIST:

- 1. In Christ I am totally accepted (Ephesians 1:6; Hebrews 13:5 LB).
- 2. Absolutely loved (Isaiah 54:10 NLT)
- 3. Completely forgiven (Romans 8:1)

INSIGHT: Never cease to offer love to others (John 13:34).

INSIGHT: If you're a follower of Jesus Christ, you must love everybody, whether you like them or not, just as Christ loved you (1 Corinthians 13:7).
