

## **MATTHEW 5:1-12 (NASB)**

The Lord's Supper is sacred in three ways:

- 1. It's a memory of the Cross.
- 2. It's a communion with Christ.
- 3. It's an act of obedience (Luke 22:19).

Two attitudes toward Baptism consistent in our day:

- 1. Obedience
- 2. Non-compliance
  - a) It's not a priority.
  - b) They want just family.
  - c) They want it private with no one (Mark 8:38).

**TRUTH:** Baptism speaks to the issue of public identification with Christ.

**INSIGHT:** Negligence regarding the Lord's Supper and/or Baptism could be because there's no real salvation.

**INSIGHT:** The Bible never points to the past to verify salvation.

## I. THE OVERALL CHARACTER OF A SAVED LIFE IS RIGHTEOUSNESS.

**INSIGHT:** A lot of people claim salvation, but you'll look a long time to find any righteous living.

**TRUTH:** A profession without discernible, habitual obedience as a lifestyle means nothing.

## II. THE STANDARDS BY WHICH TRUE BELIEVERS ARE IDENTIFIED

1. Poor in spirit, Matthew 5:3

**TRUTH:** The only people who enter heaven are those broken in their spirit over their sin.

2. Mournful in soul, Matthew 5:4

**TRUTH:** The people in heaven are there because they were broken over their sin and mourned because of its attachment to their daily lives.

## III. PUTTING IT TO A POINT, Matthew 5:14

**QUESTION:** Is your life clearly distinguishable from the rest of the world?

**TRUTH:** We don't come to Christ on our terms but His!

**TRUTH:** Faith without works is dead!
