PROVERBS 1:20-33

1. Listen to the wisdom of God. (vv. 20-22)

^[20] Wisdom cries aloud in the street,
in the markets she raises her voice;
^[21] at the head of the noisy streets she cries out;
at the entrance of the city gates she speaks:
^[22] "How long, O simple ones, will you love being simple?
How long will scoffers delight in their scoffing
and fools hate knowledge?

2. Stop refusing the gospel. (vv. 23-27)

^[23] If you turn at my reproof,
behold, I will pour out my spirit to you;
I will make my words known to you.
^[24] Because I have called and you refused to listen,
have stretched out my hand and no one has heeded,
^[25] because you have ignored all my counsel
and would have none of my reproof,
^[26] I also will laugh at your calamity;
I will mock when terror strikes you,
^[27] when terror strikes you like a storm
and your calamity comes like a whirlwind,
when distress and anguish come upon you.

John 20:19-22

[After the crucifixion and resurrection] ^[19] On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." ^[20] When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. ^[21] Jesus said to

them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." ^[22] **And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit."**

1 Corinthians 1:22-24

^[22] For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, ^[23] but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, ^[24] but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, **Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.**

3. Pursue Christ now. (vv. 32-33)

^[32] For the simple are killed by their turning away,
and the complacency of fools destroys them;

^[33] but whoever listens to me will dwell secure
and will be at ease, without dread of disaster."
