MATTHEW 2:1-12; JOB 8:8-9

TRUTH: All our opportunities are in front of us, but the lessons of life are in the past (Job 8:8-9).

INSIGHT: The Magi came to find Jesus because of the teaching of Daniel.

TRUTH: There will be a crisis in 2020, and you'll need the wisdom of Daniel.

INSIGHT: Daniel had developed the reputation of being the "go to" guy in times of trouble and confusion (Daniel 5:10-12).

HOW DO WE FACE THE FUTURE? HOW DO WE WALK THROUGH 2020?

I. WHAT NOT TO DO

1. Don't presume about tomorrow (Proverbs 27:1).

TRUTH: God hides most of our future because it would overwhelm us.

2020 FORECAST: To plan without praying is presumption.

- 2. Don't panic about tomorrow (Matthew 6:34 LB).
- 3. Don't procrastinate until tomorrow (Ecclesiastes 11:4 LB).

TRUTH: Perfectionism is the root cause of most procrastination.

II. WHAT YOU CAN COUNT ON

1. God is in control.

TRUTH: A mark of emotional maturity is realizing most of the world is out of our control.

TRUTH: The one constant of 2020 is that God's in control (1 Chronicles 29:11).

INSIGHT: Life isn't circular, repeating itself; it's linear, moving toward a focal point, a climax.

TRUTH: You are not going through random events that just happen; your life is a grand design with a purpose.

2. Your plans have a limit (Proverbs 19:21, 16:1, 16:9).

INSIGHT: Following God means I don't get a vote on the purpose and plan of my life.

THE POINT: Cooperate with God; He knows what you're made to do more than you do.

GOOD PRAYER FOR 2020: "Lord, what's the next step?"

3. My problems have a purpose (1 Peter 1:6-7).

QUESTION: Are you angry with God this morning?

THE PURPOSE OF A CHILD OF GOD: To serve the purpose of God in our generation and then going home.
