### "SAVING FAITH" John Greene, Senior Pastor

JOHN 2:23-25 (NASB) "Now, when Jesus was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing. But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, and because He did not need anyone to testify concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man."

**TRUTH:** They believed that He was the Messiah, but they didn't surrender their souls to His Lordship.

**QUESTION:** How do you know that the faith you have is saving faith? How do you know the faith you profess will get you to heaven?

# I. THE ASSURANCE OF A FAVORITE HYMN

**TRUTH:** Sinners come to Christ on the basis of faith alone: they are to come, and He will save them (John 3:16, 6:37).

## II. THE CORRUPTION OF THE GOSPEL IN OUR DAY

**INSIGHT:** Intellectual agreement to the gospel alone without a turning from a habitual life of sin isn't biblical salvation (James 2:17).

**TRUTH:** There is a false faith, and its mark is this: It's a faith that ultimately changes nothing (2 Peter 2:22).

**INSIGHT:** Finney believed theologically that salvation was a result of a human choice.

**INSIGHT:** Finney began to call people in an invitation time to what he called the "anxious bench."

**TRUTH:** It isn't Bible preaching to ask people only to believe the facts of the gospel (Luke 14:25-27).

**INSIGHT:** There are always professors who stay for a while but disappear (John 15:1-6).

**TRUTH:** There is a faith that doesn't save; it's the faith that fails, Judas faith (1 Corinthians 15:1-2; Colossians 1:21-23).

**TRUTH:** The implication is clear that if we move away and don't continue in the faith, we never were truly saved. We didn't lose our salvation, we never had it!

TRUTH: The identifying mark of true faith is perseverance (James 1:2-4, 12; 2 Timothy 2:12).

## **III. IDENTIFYING MARKS OF TRUE FAITH**

- 1. It's a gift from God (Ephesians 2:8-9; John 6:44).
- 2. Saving faith is permanent (Romans 1:17).
- 3. Saving faith is obedient (Philippians 2:13).

\*How to know you have saving faith:

1 Peter 2:7: To those who believe, Christ is precious.
