Harmony Hill Family,

As we enter another week of preparing to hold Sunday services in the Worship Center here at Harmony Hill, we are very thankful that there have been no new cases of COVID-19 reported at Harmony Hill in two weeks! Thank you to everyone who continues to observe the guidelines in place regarding cleaning, masking and social distancing.

We will continue to wear masks in the service during the worship through song, and Pastor John will instruct the congregation as to when they are allowed to remove their mask for the worship through the Word and then when to put it back on again as we dismiss. The only exception is for children 10 years of age and younger. Again, if you are unable or unwilling to wear a mask, we ask that you please join one of our online worship services.

We are also asking that on-campus worshippers continue to observe social distancing guidelines and keep their hands clean by regular washing and sanitizing. If you or anyone in your household is sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, please stay at home and join us online. If you or anyone in your household has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past we welcome you back to worship once you have fulfilled the CDC's checklist for breaking quarantine. Here are the CDC requirements:

Persons with COVID-19 who either tested positive or have symptoms and were directed to care for themselves at home may discontinue isolation under the following conditions:

- At least three days (72 hours) have passed since recovery, defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications;
- AND improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath);
- AND at least ten days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

We are looking forward to being with each other this Sunday as Stacy and Joel lead in music and Pastor John returns to the pulpit. Whether you are attending worship on campus or online know that God has called each of us to this place, at this time, to share His good news of hope and salvation in Jesus.
