MARK 4:35-41 (NASB)

CORE TRUTH: Only faith in a worthy object can see us through hard times.

QUESTION: Is it wrong to worship "online"? No

Is it God's will that this be our primary mode of worship? No

TRUTH: God wants worship to be corporate, physical gathering.

Three reasons why I believe our church family needs to make moves to regather:

- 1. The Christian faith is fueled by hearing God's Word together (Romans 10:17).
- 2. Hearing God's Word from pastors on "The Hill" will impact you more than a preacher from another church family.
- 3. There is power in a personal connection.

LET'S READ OUR TEXT!

QUESTION: Why is it that so many Christians have such a mild case of Christianity? Why do so many have such little, small faith?

ANSWER: It is because we have a wrong view of what it means to have faith.

TRUTH: We don't learn faith by lecture but in life.

THREE LESSONS FOR ALL OF US:

I. BIBLICAL FAITH DEPENDS ON ITS OBJECT.

TRUTH: The Bible never says, "just believe," but believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.

TRUTH: It isn't the amount of faith you have that matters, but in whom your faith rests.

TRUTH: Our God's too small is the great problem of American Christianity today.

II. FAITH CAN BE ENLARGED.

TRUTH: God's issue in COVID-19 isn't to relieve our misery but to develop our faith.

TRUTH: Biblical salvation has three tenses in it: the past... salvation from the penalty of sin, that's the Cross; the future... We will be saved from the presence of sin, that's the Rapture; but the middle is the right now, when God is saving us from the power of sin.

The question this morning: As you profess to know Christ, where's the proof that you're not just growing old but actually growing up in Christ?

III. FAITH HAS PROBLEMS (1 Corinthians 10:13).

INSIGHT: The test of troubles is whether you will hold up or fold up.

TAKE AWAY/INVITATION: NUMBERS 13

INSIGHT: Remember the majority isn't always right.

INSIGHT: Joshua and Caleb weren't blind to the impossibility of their situation, but they also saw God.

TWO TRUTHS TO MAKE PART OF YOUR DAILY LIFE:

- 1. If Jesus Christ is IN your boat... it will never sink.
- 2. If Jesus Christ is in your boat... the storm will not last forever.
