WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHILE ATTENDING HARMONY HILL?

- Service times are currently 8:30 and 10:30. **New Service times beginning August 16 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30**. There will be childcare available for all three services beginning August 16.
- You may enter the Worship Center at any time. The sanctuary doors will be closed briefly for cleaning between services.
- Adult Life Groups are resuming. The meeting rooms will not be cleaned between services. Cleaning supplies are available in each room so that groups may clean prior to meeting.
- Student Life Groups are resuming at 10 a.m. in the Student Center.
- Valet parking will not be offered at this time, however, we will have golf carts available for those needing assistance from their car to the building.
- We will have greeters (wearing masks) at the door, holding the door open, ready to receive you.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available.
- Masks will be available for those who might not have one.
- The Café will be open, offering coffee, water, and a select assortment of snacks. Water fountains will be available.

- The Next Steps Desk will be open for any questions or needs.
- Deacons will be present in both services to assist members in finding seats that are adequate for their family size. Chairs are set up for social distancing.
- In the seat backs, you will find Life Point outlines, connect cards, offering envelopes, and pens. The pens are for your use—if you use the pen, please take it with you. The Life Point outline is also available on our website or app for you to print.
- Offering will be collected at the conclusion of the service at the exits.
- We are no longer requiring immediate exit following services, but please wear a mask while conversing with others.
- Baptisms may be scheduled to take place in the 11:30 service. Call the church office to schedule.

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM OUR CHURCH MEMBERS?

- Wear a mask to enter the Worship Center. We will continue to wear masks in the service during the worship through song, and Pastor John will instruct the congregation as to when they are allowed to remove their mask for the worship through the Word and then when to put it back on again as we dismiss. The only exception is for children 10 years of age and younger. If you are unable or unwilling to wear a mask, we ask that you please join one of our online worship services.
- Wash hands upon entry or use sanitation stations.
- Don't come if not feeling well or if anyone in your household is not feeling well.
- Those over 65 or immune-compromised are encouraged to stay home for now.
- · Cover coughs and sneezes.
- We encourage refraining from handshakes; instead greet with fist or elbow bumps. We ask that you be mindful of our church members who prefer no physical contact.

Harmony Hill continues to place a high priority on health and safety for everyone who enters our facilities. As we gather together in larger numbers and with more frequency, our hope is that the body of Christ will be strengthened by the sweet fellowship that we have always enjoyed together. God is continuing to move here on The Hill, and we are anticipating many great things in the days ahead as we gather together.
