WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US

- Professionally cleaned rooms and bathrooms.
- Lots of hand sanitizer. Adults and children will be required to clean hands after each activity.
- Teachers will wear masks.
- Children will be sent home if they have a runny nose, fever, cough, or any signs of sickness. Post-COVID means we have to take greater precautions to protect, so if your child is suffering from allergies, stay home. We will not be administering temperature checks BUT a child with a temperature of 100.4° or more will be sent home, and the child will be fever-free for 24 hours without medicine before they can return to the Children's Center or Admin Center for activities.
- We are doing our best to make room capacities at a smaller level, especially in preschool.
- Toys, games, supplies, etc. will be changed out after each service. Those will be sterilized for the next meeting time and new supplies will be introduced for each service that have been cleaned and sterilized. Our STEP program will change out supplies multiple times throughout the day.

- Staff will fill water pitchers to be used in rooms so that only teachers with gloves are dispensing the water. All paper water cups will be thrown away after single use. At this time we will not be using water bottles on Wednesday nights. STEP and MOPS will follow the same procedures.
- We will not be providing Wednesday night meals at this time. STEP will continue with children bringing their lunch on Tuesday and Thursday but no "Brown Bag" at this time.
- Check-in computers will be wiped down by greeters (and parents can help) as much as possible during check-in times. They will be cleaned thoroughly before each service.
- Indoor Playground ("BACKYARD") IF used, will be sanitized after each class.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

- · No sick children.
- ONLY ONE adult/teenager/grandparent/guardian for drop-off and pick-up. We are asking that all other adults stay outside the building.
- EVERY adult/teenager/grandparent/guardian MUST wear a mask while in the building for drop-off and pick-up.
- Wednesday night snack or meal for your child. Programming of Bible and Activities will not begin until 6:30 p.m. so that you have time to get food for your family. You can still drop off at 5:45 p.m. to get to your Life Group location but you MUST bring food for your child.
- Sunday snacks will still be provided. STEP, MOPS and Sunday mornings will still provide snacks.
- STEP nap bedding must be carried home every day.
