"WHAT DISCIPLES DO"

MATTHEW 28:18-20a

CORE STATEMENT: The central work, the all-consuming focus of Christ's Churches is to make disciples who make disciples, or DMD's.

TRUTH: Biblical Christianity isn't about making converts; it's about making disciples, and not just disciples but DMD's: disciples who make disciples.

Let's read MATTHEW 28:19.

INSIGHT: Above all that the church does day to day, making disciples who make disciples is the core.

I. WHAT A DISCIPLE IS

TRUTH: Heaven doesn't celebrate buildings, baptisms, or budgets, only disciples (Luke 15:7).

INSIGHT: A disciple did not merely want to know what his master knew, but to do what his master did.

TRUTH: Disciple making isn't about ability but availability.

INSIGHT: You maybe can't teach like me, but you can invite someone into your life to observe your walk with Jesus, to show them how to follow Jesus like you follow Him.

II. WHAT DISCIPLES DO: FIVE CORE IDENTITIES

1. A worshipper, one who treasures Christ and His Word (Matthew 22:37-38)

TRUTH: A disciple is first and foremost a worshipper.

2. A family member, living in community (Matthew 12:46-50)

*A disciple believes AND belongs.

3. A disciple is a servant living in generosity (John 13:4-5).

4. A disciple is a steward.

INSIGHT: Your money isn't your own.

5. A disciple is a witness (Matthew 4:19).
