"FOLLOWING JESUS ISN'T EASY" John Greene, Senior Pastor

MATTHEW 1:18-25

CORE STATEMENT: Service to Christ will inconvenience your life.

QUESTION: Why did Mary and Joseph go through all they went through from the perceived sinful pregnancy, the challenges of bringing a baby to term and the job relocation to Egypt?

ANSWER: Because for them, Jesus was worth it.

QUESTION: What is Jesus worth to you? Are you on board with God and His mission?

TRUTH: There are a lot of people who lack the resolve to wholeheartedly follow Jesus.

INSIGHT: To actually follow Jesus is difficult. Following Him is joyous, difficult, and life-altering (John 10:10; Psalm 16:11); but then there's Matthew 16:24, "If anyone desires to come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me."

QUESTION: Does the resurrection have to be true for you to consider your life good? If not, then you're not living a life of sacrifice.

INSIGHT: We'll never have a sacrificial gift to reach the next generation of children from you, unless you have a strong grasp of why Jesus is worth your sacrifice.

I. FOLLOWING JESUS REQUIRES FAITH AND ABSOLUTE SUBMISSION.

INSIGHT: During the betrothal one was considered married, and getting out meant a legal divorce.

TRUTH: The will of God for Mary to birth Jesus destroyed Mary's hopes of a beautiful wedding day and family celebration that would have occurred at the end of the year of waiting.

INSIGHT: The virgin birth ruined both Mary's and Joseph's reputations.

INSIGHT: The Holy Spirit is laying out for us in the first Christmas what people will have to go through to follow Christ.

TRUTH: You will struggle with being sacrificial when you lack confidence in the promises of the unseen God.

TRUTH: Forgiving an abuser requires seeing God's forgiveness is bigger than yours and God's ability to work all things for good is greater than others' abilities to inflict evil upon you.

II. FOLLOWING JESUS MEANS DYING TO YOURSELF.

TRUTH: Mary and Joseph had to die to personal dreams to follow God's will.

INVITATION

TRUTH: Joseph was invited by God to share in the suffering of Jesus.

TRUTH: Serving Jesus is rarely convenient.

INSIGHT: People in our church who serve the community don't do it because it's convenient but because of their commitment to Jesus.

INSIGHT: Not every ministry is for everyone, but do you have a ministry that is inconvenient for you? If not, then there's a good chance you're not following Jesus.
