

LUKE 6:43-49

CORE STATEMENT: In 2020, God shook us for the purpose of waking us up and asking: "What are you trusting in? What are you building your life on? Is it going to last?"

QUESTION FOR 2021: "Am I ALL IN on the mission of God?"

TRUTH: When GOD seems to be attacking our foundation... what we see is it's actually not cruelty but mercy.

INSIGHT: God is showing us that all these places where we are placing our security are not going to endure.

INSIGHT: It is always God's mercy that shakes the foundations of our lives.

TRUTH: When interpreting the Bible, context is always king.

Luke 6:43-49 is about sincere religious people who are self-deceived and lost but think they're heaven-bound. There are three marks of self-deceived religious people:

I. THEY DON'T BEAR SPIRITUAL FRUIT (v. 43).

What evidence marks salvation?

- 1. A growing love for Jesus
- 2. A love for God's people
- 3. An ever-increasing dislike of sin

TRUTH: It's impossible to come to Christ and not change.

QUESTION: Does your life show the marks of God at work in your life?

- 1. Do you have a growing love for Jesus?
- 2. Are you zealous to see other people come to know Him?
- 3. Do you find the commands of Christ burdensome, or are you attracted to them?

INSIGHT: A desire for God, not for heaven, is evidence of God's work in you.

II. THE SELF-DECEIVED DON'T DO WHAT JESUS SAYS.

- 1. They worship Jesus on Sundays, but their wallets belong to them, not Jesus.
- 2. They claim Jesus, but their career and life dreams are off limits.
- 3. There's a relationship in their life that's out of God's will, but they won't surrender.

III. THE FAITH OF THE SELF-DECEIVED FALLS APART IN THE STORMS OF LIFE.

INSIGHT: There are people whose walk with Jesus is fine until it gets hard.

TRUTH: At some point obedience to Christ will call for a 180 from what you want to do, and in that moment, real Christianity shows its true colors.
