GOAL FOR THE MORNING: For Harmony Hill families to enjoy worship together and for each person to leave with an encouragement toward a step of godly obedience.

1.	Today's Bible Story: The Prophet Samuel's Origin Story (1 Samuel 1-3)
	Write down any parts of the story you find interesting or have a question about.
2.	The Parent Response (1 Samuel 1:26-28)
	INSIGHT: This story gives a tale of two families: one based on religion and the other based on relationship.
	PARENT'S PRAYER: "For as long as lives, they belong to the Lord."
3.	The Church Response (1 Samuel 3)
	INSIGHT: The church partners with families to teach our children to hear the Lord's voice and obey.
	CHURCH PRAYER: "If He calls you, say, 'Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening.'" (1 Samuel 3:9).

4. Child/Youth Response (1 Samuel 3:19; 3:10)

INSIGHT: It is your responsibility to obey the Lord when you hear His voice.

CHILD/YOUTH PRAYER: "Speak, for Your servant is listening."

NEXT STEPS: At lunch today, brainstorm ideas of things you can do together this summer to build up the faith in your family.
