| INSIGHT: The transfiguration of Christ validated the confession of Peter (Lk. 9:20). | |
| INSIGHT: The transfiguration of Christ demonstrated the worthiness of Christ to endure sacrifice (Lk. 9:23 | –25). |

| 3) By sharing our firsthand experiences of the majesty of Christ (2 Pet. 1:16-18) | |
| INSIGHT: Mountaintop experiences give us eyewitness status for telling others about Jesus. | |
