"GUARD THE GOSPEL" John Greene | Senior Pastor

2 TIMOTHY 1:13-14 (ESV), "Hold on to the pattern of wholesome teaching you learned from me...Through the power of the Holy Spirit who lives within us, carefully GUARD THE PRECIOUS TRUTH (the gospel) THAT HAS BEEN ENTRUSTED TO YOU."

INSIGHT: Pastoral succession is a relay race that must be finished well.

INSIGHT: My effectiveness as a leader would be determined not by what our church had accomplished, but how well I stepped down and passed the leadership baton.

I. PASTORAL SUCCESSION IS LIKE A RELAY RACE.

II. PAUL'S SENSE OF TIMING

- a. Paul is imprisoned, and though imprisoned several times, Rome is different.
- b. Paul realized his circle of influence was shrinking.

TRUTH: Paul sensed the thrust of his ministry was diminishing and that the time had arrived to pass his mantle to another, more influential servant.

- c. Paul was growing older.
- d. Paul's missionary trips and hardships had worn him down.

INSIGHT: I'm growing older and don't have quite the energy for new projects I once had.

III. TIMOTHY WAS READY TO RECEIVE THE BATON OF LEADERSHIP.

LOVING ADMONITION: Be on guard against holding to the past.

INSIGHT: We are in a God-appointed time of intentional transition of leadership.

TRUTH: I am preaching this message and have planned next Sunday's with one end: that my time has a definite ending and Todd's has a definite beginning.

IV. PASSING LEADERSHIP ASSUMES RECOGNIZED GIFTING.

TRUTH: Todd Core has been gifted of God to teach the Word and organize and lead God's people.

TRUTH: There are good teachers and pastors in Lufkin, but there's no better communicator of God's Word than Todd Core.

ADMONITION: Keep the main thing the main thing.

V. GUARD THE GOSPEL (2 Timothy 1:13-14).

PASTORAL TRUTH: Your goal is to carry the baton of the gospel across the finish line.

INSIGHT: There are three internal attacks in every church:

- 2 Tim. 2:17-18, false teaching confront it.
- 1 Cor. 5, flagrant immorality put a light on it.
- Titus 3:10, continual divisiveness confront it, resolve it, or kick it out.
