"HE PREVAILS OVER REJECTION" Todd Core | Lead Pastor

TEXT: Matthew 21:33-46

In this passage, Jesus gives a parable and an explanation to illustrate that God's plans will not be thwarted by man's rejection.

nan's rejection.
. Understanding the parable (vv. 33-41)
TRUTH: Jesus tells this parable as a response to the Jewish leaders questioning His authority.
KEY PLAYERS: Vineyard owner = God the Father Vineyard = God's Kingdom Tenants = Israel/Jewish Leaders Servants = OT Prophets Owner's Son = Jesus
. Understanding the lessons of the parable and the explanation (vv. 33-46)
TRUTH: God has demonstrated extreme measure of patience with Israel even in the midst of their rejection of His prophets and His Son (vv. 35-39).
TRUTH: God's plans will not be thwarted by man's rejection. Christ prevails over rejection and has become the chief cornerstone (v. 42).
TRUTH: There are severe consequences for rejecting Jesus (vv. 43-44).

TRUTH: We will either build our life upon Jesus or be crushed by His judgment.

MEMORY VERSE: John 11:25-26 – Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?"
