

"HE PREVAILS OVER BETRAYAL" Todd Core | Lead Pastor

TEXT: Matthew 26:47-56

We will examine 3 ways that Jesus prevailed over betrayal by willingly following God's plan.

1)	Jesus allowed the betrayal (vv. 47-50).
	NOTE: Beware of the slippery slope which led to Judas betraying Jesus.
2)	Jesus allowed His arrest (vv. 51-53).
	NOTE: Beware of the impulse that led Peter to cut off the ear of Malchus.
	Jesus accepted being unfairly treated because God's plan was being fulfilled (vv. 54-56).
	NOTE: Beware of minimizing your own culpability in betraying, abandoning, and mistreating Jesus. Yet Jesus prevails!

MEMORY VERSE: John 11:25-26 – Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?"
