

TEXT: 2 Peter 1:16-21

In this passage, Peter is writing to give an apologetical argument to support the second coming of Christ as a trustworthy promise. Secondarily, he gives us an apologetical argument for the trustworthiness of the Bible.

Reasons we can trust the Bible:

 1) The Bible contains reliable accounts (vv. 16-18). Eyewitness testimony Historical accuracy Transmission accuracy 	
 2) The Bible has evidence of being God-inspired (vv. 19-21). Jesus endorsed the Old Testament and authorized the New Testament. The canon of scripture was affirmed early. Prophecy fulfilled 	
3) If you can accept reasons 1 and 2, then you do well to pay attention to the Bible (v. 19).
