## "HOUSEHOLD CODES" Todd Core | Lead Pastor

TEXT: Ephesians 5:22-6:4

**SERIES PURPOSE:** This series is a call to pursue spiritual maturity as part of our church's desire to see spiritually healthy households in Angelina County.

**INTRODUCTORY REMARK:** The topic of today's message is both unpopular and often misunderstood because of our growing disdain for the concept of submitting to authority.

Understanding the Passage:

1) God has ordained certain roles for the home (5:22, 25, 6:1).				

**NOTE:** These roles do not negate the fact that men, women, and children are equal in creation and redemption.

- 2) Living within God's ordained roles is an act of worship.
  - a) A wife who submits to the authority of her husband illustrates the church's submission to Christ (5:22-24).
  - b) A husband who puts his wife's well-being above his own illustrates Christ's love for the church (5:25-32).
  - c) A child who honors his/her parents learns to submit to the authority of God (6:1-3).
  - d) A parent who raises a child to fear the Lord will gain them as brothers/sisters in Christ (6:4).
- 3) Pastoral Advice about Application
  - a) Don't rationalize this passage away.
  - b) Don't weaponize this passage.
  - c) Do maximize the gifts of those in your household.
